Most Christian denominations hold church services on the Lord's Day (offering Sunday morning and Sunday evening services); a number of traditions have mid-week services, while some traditions worship on a Saturday. In addition to this, many Christians attend services on holy days such as Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Ascension Thursday, among others depending on the Christian denomination 02e0cc1fe6

Book of Common Prayer (1662) In continuous print and regular use for over 360 years, the 1662 prayer book is the basis for numerous other editions of the Book of Common Prayer and other liturgical texts. Noted for both its devotional and literary quality, the 1662 prayer book has influenced the English language, with its use alongside the King James Version of the Bible contributing to an increase in literacy from the 16th to the 20th century. Wesley Methodist Church developed its own service book, the 1882 Public Prayers and Services, based directly off the Book of Common Prayer rather than Wesley's The 1662 Book of Common Prayer is an authorised liturgical book of the Church of England and other Anglican bodies around the world 02e0cc1fe6

Prayer Prayer is an invocation or act that seeks to activate a rapport with an object of worship through deliberate communication. Prayers may be recited from memory, read from a book of prayers, or composed spontaneously or “impromptu”. In the narrow sense, the term refers to an act of supplication or intercession directed towards a deity or a deified ancestor. with others; a laying on of hands and others.
