History of science This was the period (8th–14th century CE) of the Islamic Golden Age The history of science covers the development of science from ancient times to the present. It encompasses all three major branches of science: natural, social, and formal. John Philoponus’s criticism of Aristotelian physics, and the works of Dioscorides. Protoscience, early sciences, and natural philosophies such as alchemy and astrology that existed during the Bronze Age, Iron Age, classical antiquity and the Middle Ages, declined during the early modern period after the establishment of formal disciplines of science in the Age of Enlightenment 5a52f01bac

There are a few alternative timelines. Some scholars extend the end date of the golden age to around 1350, including the Timurid Renaissance... 5a52f01bac The earliest roots of scientific thinking and practice can be traced to Ancient Egypt and Mesopotamia during the 3rd and 2nd millennia BCE. These civilizations' contributions to mathematics, astronomy, and medicine influenced later Greek natural philosophy of classical antiquity, wherein formal attempts were made to provide explanations... 5a52f01bac

Metalloid The word metalloid comes from the Latin metallum ("metal") and the Greek oeides ("resembling in form or appearance"). by hydrogen sulfide even from strongly acid solutions and is displaced in a free form from sulfate solutions; it is deposited on the cathode on electrolysis A metalloid is a chemical element which has a preponderance of properties in between, or that are a mixture of, those of metals and nonmetals. Despite the lack of specificity, the term remains in use in the literature. There is no standard definition of a metalloid and no complete agreement on which elements are metalloids 5a52f01bac

This period is traditionally understood to have begun during the reign of the Abbasid caliph Harun al-Rashid (786 to 809) with the inauguration of the House of Wisdom, which saw scholars from all over the Muslim world flock to Baghdad, the world's largest city at the time, to translate the known world's classical knowledge into Arabic and Persian. The period is traditionally said to have ended with the collapse of the Abbasid caliphate due to Mongol invasions and the Siege of Baghdad in 1258. 5a52f01bac

The six commonly recognised metalloids are boron, silicon, germanium, arsenic, antimony and tellurium. Five elements are less frequently so classified: carbon, aluminium, selenium, polonium and astatine. On a standard periodic table, all eleven elements are in a diagonal region of the p-block extending from boron at the upper left to astatine at lower right... 5a52f01bac

Nonmetal Physically, they are usually lighter (less dense) than elements that form metals and are often poor conductors of heat and electricity. They range from colorless gases like hydrogen to shiny crystals like iodine. Drawing on this, in 1864 the “Manual of Metalloids” divided all elements into either metals In the context of the periodic table, a nonmetal is a chemical element that mostly lacks distinctive metallic properties. form negatively charged ions with oxygen in aqueous solutions. Chemically, nonmetals have relatively high electronegativity or usually attract electrons in a chemical bond with another element, and their oxides tend to be acidic 5a52f01bac

Seventeen elements are widely recognized as nonmetals. Additionally, some or all of six borderline elements (metalloids) are sometimes counted as nonmetals. 5a52f01bac

Maria Montessori At an early age, Montessori enrolled in classes at an all-boys technical school, with hopes of becoming an engineer. She did well in Maria Tecla Artemisia Montessori (MON-tiss-OR-ee; Italian: [ma'ri:a montes'so:ri]; 31 August 1870 – 6 May 1952) was an Italian physician and educator best known for her philosophy of education (the Montessori method) and her writing on scientific pedagogy. Her educational method is in use today in many public and private schools globally. Italian, mathematics, history, geography, geometric and ornate drawing, physics, chemistry, botany, zoology, and two foreign languages. She soon had a change of heart and began medical school at the Sapienza University of Rome, becoming one of the first women to attend medical school in Italy; she graduated with honors in 1896 5a52f01bac
