SSI provisions of seismic design codes are optional and allow designers to reduce the design base shear of buildings by considering Ground-structure interaction (SSI) consists of the interaction between soil (ground) and a structure built upon it. Various combinations of soil and structure can either amplify or diminish movement and subsequent damage. A second interaction effect, tied to mechanical properties of soil, is the sinking of foundations, worsened by a seismic event. It is primarily an exchange of mutual stress, whereby the movement of the ground-structure system is influenced by both the type of ground and the type of structure 8db37f4b82

2005 Kashmir earthquake The severity of the damage caused by the earthquake is attributed to severe upthrust. 6 on the Richter scale and had a maximum Mercalli intensity of XI (Extreme). Its epicenter was 19 km northeast of the city of Muzaffarabad, and 90 km north north-east of Islamabad, the capital city of Pakistan, and also affected nearby Balakot in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and some areas of Jammu and Kashmir, India. with the largest damaged bridge in Balakot. Several other bridges in the Jhelum Valley (Kashmir) were also damaged. Although not the largest

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earthquake to hit this region in terms of magnitude it is considered the deadliest, surpassing the 1935 Quetta earthquake. The bridges in Muzaffarabad were not. An earthquake occurred at 08:50:39 Pakistan Standard Time on 8 October 2005 in Azad Jammu and Kashmir, a territory under Pakistan. The earthquake was also felt in Afghanistan, Tajikistan, India and the Xinjiang region. It registered a moment magnitude of 7.8
