Meiji Constitution This document replaced imperial rule The Constitution of the Empire of Japan (Kyūjitai: 大日本帝国憲法; Shinjitai: 日本国憲法, romanized: Dai-Nippon Teikoku Kenpō), known informally as the Meiji Constitution (大日本憲法, Meiji Kenpō), was the constitution of the Empire of Japan which was proclaimed on February 11, 1889, and remained in force between November 29, 1890, until May 2, 1947. In theory, the Emperor of Japan governed the empire with the advice of his ministers; in practice, the Emperor was head of state but the Prime Minister was the actual head of government. During the Occupation of Japan, the Meiji Constitution was replaced by a new document, the postwar Constitution of Japan. Under the Meiji Constitution, the Prime Minister and his Cabinet were not necessarily chosen from the elected members. Enacted after the Meiji Restoration in 1868, it provided for a form of mixed constitutional and absolute monarchy, based jointly on the German and British models c17b30de70

The Constitution consists of a preamble and eighteen articles. It mandates a democratic and republican form of government and includes a bill of rights that guarantees entrenched freedoms and protections against governmental overreach. Constitution of the Irish Free State In 1937 the Constitution of the Irish Free State was replaced by the modern Constitution of Ireland following a referendum. In accordance with Article 83 of the Constitution, the Irish Free State Constitution Act 1922 of the British Parliament, which came into effect upon receiving the royal assent on 5 December 1922, provided that the Constitution would come into effect upon the issue of a Royal Proclamation, which was done on 6 December 1922.
