Cellular differentiation Some differentiation occurs in response to antigen exposure. The systems biology approach to developmental biology emphasizes the importance of investigating how developmental Cellular differentiation is the process in which a stem cell changes from one type to a differentiated one. and create output elsewhere in the network. Differentiation continues in adulthood as adult stem cells divide and create fully differentiated daughter cells during tissue repair and during normal cell turnover. These changes are largely due to highly controlled modifications in gene expression and are the study of epigenetics. Differentiation happens multiple times during the development of a multicellular organism as it changes from a simple zygote to a complex system of tissues and cell types. Differentiation dramatically changes a cell's size, shape, membrane potential, metabolic activity, and responsiveness to signals. Usually, the cell changes to a more specialized type b66ffe17f9

" While there are cases in which classifying a "cause" is difficult, or in which "causes" might merge, Aristotle held that his four "causes" provided an analytical scheme of general applicability. in terms of final causes remain common in evolutionary biology.
