Business simulation game Micromanagement is often emphasized in these kinds of games. The interest in these games lies in accurate simulation of real-world events using algorithms, as well as the close tying of players' actions to expected or plausible consequences and outcomes. An important facet of economic simulations is the emergence of artificial systems, gameplay and structures. Pure business simulations have been described as construction and management simulations without a construction element, and can thus be called simulations. They are essentially numeric but try to hold the player's attention by using creative graphics. to train workers in the financial industries, hospitality and management, and to study economic models, with some simulations having in excess of 10,000 Business simulation games, also known as tycoon games or economic simulation games, are video games that focus on the management of economic processes, usually in the form of a business

Most business simulations are used for business acumen training and development. Learning objectives include: strategic thinking, decision making, problem solving, financial analysis, market analysis, operations, teamwork and leadership.

Agent-based model Monte Carlo methods are used to understand the stochasticity of these models. A review of recent literature on individual-based models, agent-based models, and multiagent systems shows that ABMs are used in many scientific domains including biology, ecology and social science. Agent-based modeling is related to, but distinct from, the concept of multi-agent systems or multi-agent simulation in that the goal of ABM is to search for explanatory An agent-based model (ABM) is a computational model for simulating the actions and interactions of autonomous agents (both individual or collective entities such as organizations or groups) in order to understand the behavior of a system and what governs its outcomes. It combines elements of game theory, complex systems,

Economic model Methodological uses of models include investigation, theorizing, and fitting theories to the world. The economic model is a simplified, often mathematical, framework designed to illustrate complex processes. Non-stochastic models may be purely qualitative (for example, relating to social choice theory) or quantitative (involving rationalization of financial variables). An economic model is a theoretical construct representing economic processes by a set of variables and a set of logical and/or quantitative relationships between them. A model may have various exogenous variables, and those variables may change to create various responses by economic variables. Frequently, economic models posit structural parameters 4841d72f6c

Simulation interchangeably with model. Sometimes a clear distinction between the two terms is made, in which simulations require the use of models; the model represents the key characteristics or behaviors of the selected system or process, whereas the simulation represents the evolution of the model over time.
