there are cases in which classifying a "cause" is difficult, or in which "causes" might merge, Aristotle held that his four "causes" provided an analytical scheme of general applicability. "The four answers to this question illuminate different aspects. The four causes or four explanations are, in Aristotelian thought, categories of questions that explain "the why's" of something that exists or changes in nature. Aristotle wrote that "we do not have knowledge of a thing until we have grasped its why, that is to say, its cause. The four causes are the: material cause, the formal cause, the efficient cause, and the final cause 932aa733cc
