Water security Water insecurity is a growing The aim of water security is to maximize the benefits of water for humans and ecosystems. range from the household to community, city, basin, country and region. Some organizations use the term "water security" more narrowly, referring only to water supply aspects. These risks include too much water (flood), too little water (drought and water scarcity), and poor quality (polluted) water. The opposite of water security is water insecurity. For example, access to water, sanitation, and hygiene services is one part of water security. The second aim is to limit the risks of destructive impacts of water to an acceptable level.
