Smoke detector Smoke detectors/alarms are usually housed in plastic enclosures, typically shaped like a disk about 125 millimetres (5 in) in diameter and 25 millimetres (1 in) thick, but shape and size vary. Sensitive detectors can be used to detect and deter smoking in banned areas. A 2004 A smoke detector is a device that senses smoke, typically as an indicator of fire. Detectors may use one or both sensing methods. Hydrogen safety The storage and use of hydrogen poses unique challenges due to its ease of leaking as a gaseous fuel, low-energy ignition, wide range of combustible fuel-air mixtures, buoyancy, and its ability to embrittle metals that must be accounted for to ensure safe operation. Ignition can occur at a volumetric ratio of hydrogen to air as low

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as 4% due to the oxygen in the air and the simplicity and chemical properties of the reaction. Hydrogen possesses the NFPA 704's highest rating of four on the flammability scale because it is flammable. Hydrogen safety covers the safe production, handling and use of hydrogen, particularly hydrogen gas fuel and liquid hydrogen. Hydrogen possesses the NFPA 704's highest rating of four on the flammability scale because it is flammable when mixed even in small amounts with ordinary air. Typically, a fire extinguisher consists of a hand-held cylindrical pressure vessel containing an agent that can be discharged to extinguish a fire.
