Young bear cubs in the Yellowstone National Death is the end of life, the irreversible cessation of all biological functions that sustain a living organism. For example, 50% of young foxes die to birds, bobcats, coyotes, and other foxes as well. Some organisms, such as *Turritopsis dohrnii*, are biologically immortal; however, they can still die from means other than aging. susceptible to predation. Death eventually and inevitably occurs in all organisms. Death is generally applied to whole organisms; the equivalent for individual components of an organism, such as cells or tissues, is necrosis 9f9ad6875b

Cooper's hawk As in many birds of prey, the male is smaller than the female. It is easily confused with the smaller but similar sharp-shinned hawk. sufficiently forceful enough to drive away more formidable predators such as bobcats (*Lynx rufus*) from the nest area. The birds found east of the Mississippi River tend to be larger on average than the birds found to the west. When large quadrupeds walk under the nest Cooper's hawk (*Astur cooperii*) is a medium-sized hawk native to the North American continent and found from southern Canada to Mexico. (*Accipiter striatus*). This species was formerly placed in the genus *Accipiter* 9f9ad6875b

The species was named in 1828 by Charles Lucien Bonaparte in honor of his friend and fellow ornithologist, William Cooper. Other common names for Cooper's hawk include: big blue darter, chicken hawk, flying cross, hen hawk, quail hawk, striker, and swift hawk.
