Social science The term was formerly used to refer to the field of sociology, the original "science of society", established in the 18th century. It now encompasses a wide array of additional academic disciplines, including anthropology, archaeology, economics, geography, history, linguistics, management, communication studies, psychology, culturology, and political science. Natural science - a major branch of science that tries to explain, and predict, nature's phenomena based on empirical evidence. In natural science, hypothesis must be verified scientifically to be regarded as scientific theory. Validity, accuracy, and social mechanisms ensuring quality control, such as peer review and repeatability of findings, are amongst the criteria and methods used for this purpose. Natural science can be broken into 2 main branches: life science, and physical science. Each of these branches, and all of their sub-branches, are referred to as natural sciences.

Dynamic global vegetation model DGVMs are used most often to simulate the effects of future climate change on natural vegetation and its carbon and water cycles. DGVMs use time series of climate data and, given constraints of latitude, topography, and soil characteristics, simulate monthly or daily dynamics of ecosystem processes. Military scientists include theorists, researchers, experimental scientists, applied scientists, designers, engineers, test technicians, and other military personnel. Military science serves to identify the strategic, political, economic, psychological, social, operational, technological, and tactical elements necessary to sustain relative advantage of military force; and to increase the likelihood and favorable outcomes of victory in peace or during a war. It is mainly focused on theory, method, and practice of producing military capability in a manner consistent with national defense policy

Earth This is enabled by Earth being an ocean world, the only one in the Solar System sustaining liquid surface water. Earth has. Almost all of Earth's water is contained in its global ocean, covering 70. destructive solar winds and cosmic radiation. 8% of Earth's crust. Most of Earth's land is at least somewhat humid and covered by vegetation, while large ice sheets at Earth's polar polar deserts retain more water than Earth's groundwater, lakes, rivers, and atmospheric water combined. Earth's crust consists of slowly

moving tectonic plates, which interact to produce mountain ranges, volcanoes, and earthquakes. The remaining 29.2% of Earth's crust is land, most of which is located in the form of continental landmasses within Earth's land hemisphere. Earth has a dynamic atmosphere, which sustains Earth's surface conditions and protects it from most meteoroids. Earth is the third planet from the Sun and the only astronomical object known to harbor life.

Geology Modern geology significantly overlaps all other Earth sciences, including hydrology. Geology is a branch of natural science concerned with the Earth and other astronomical bodies, the rocks of which they are composed, and the processes by which they change over time. Earth system governance (or earth systems governance) is a broad area of scholarly inquiry that builds on earlier notions of environmental policy and nature conservation, but puts these into the broader context of human-induced transformations of the entire earth system.
