These acquisitions are financed through a combination of debt and equity. Cambridge Associates defines growth buyouts as being a highly growth oriented form of private equity strategy, in contrast to more leverage-oriented strategies like leveraged buyouts (LBO). The holding company in growth buyout transactions seeks to create revenue growth in the portfolio company by expanding market share. This model has also been called "buy and build".
