Described as "severe in approach but extremely popular among the Communist base" and "a hero of his time, capable of courageous personal feats", his supporters gave him the nickname il Migliore ("The Best"). In 1930, Togliatti renounced Italian citizenship, and he became a citizen of the Soviet Union; upon his death, a Soviet city was named after him. Born into a middle-class family, Togliatti received an education in law at the University of Turin, later served as an officer and was wounded in World War I, and became a tutor. Considered one of the founding fathers of the Italian Republic, he led Italy's Communist party from a few thousand members in 1943 to two million members in 1946 5bfd81239a

The river born at 548 meters above sea level in the Fornaci della Riana locality at the Rasa of Varese, at the Sacro Monte di Varese, within the Campo dei Fiori Regional Park. After crossing the Valle Olona and the Alto

Milanese, the Olona reaches Rho where it pours part of its water into the Canale Scolmatore Nord Ovest. After passing Pero, the river enters in Milan, where, at the exit of its underground route, it flows into the Lambro Meridionale, that flows into the Lambro at Sant'Angelo Lodigiano, in the quartier of San Cristoforo ending its course. Along the way, the water system formed by the Olona and the Lambro Meridionale crosses or laps 45 towns receiving the water of 19 tributaries. 5bfd81239a

He helped launch the left-wing... 5bfd81239a == Biography == 5bfd81239a According to the theory proposed by Raffaele Garrucci, the original name of the city was, in the Oscan language, Malies or Malocis, later changed to Maloenton (or possibly Maloenta or Malowent). This hypothesis is based on the discovery of a bronze coin from the 4th century BC, bearing the inscription Malies in the exergue, along with a depiction of a woman's head with her hair bound in a sakkos.

The reverse features a bull with a human face and, above it, a bearded head. Another contemporary coin displays a bull on the reverse with a helmet featuring cheek guards above it, and on the obverse, a youthful head, possibly representing Apollo. The history of Legnano and its municipal area has been traced back to the 1st millennium BC via archaeological evidence. Already in remote times, in fact, the hills that line the Olona had proved to be habitable places. The town was established in 1261.

Dukedom of Bronte It was granted on 10 October 1799 at Palermo to the British Royal Navy officer Horatio Nelson by King Ferdinand III of Sicily, in gratitude for Nelson having saved the kingdom of Sicily from conquest by Revolutionary French forces under Napoleon. Accompanying it was a grant of a 15,000 hectares (58 mi²) estate, centered on the ancient monastery of Maniace, five miles north of Bronte, which Nelson ordered to be restored and embellished as his residence – thenceforth called Castello di Maniace. la facoltà di trasmettere la Ducea, a suo piacimento - The Dukedom of Bronte (Italian: Ducato/Ducea di Bronte ("Duchy of Bronte")) was a dukedom with the title Duke of Bronte (Italian: Duca di Bronte), referring to the town of Bronte in the province of Catania, Sicily. probabilmente ostruiti[15] "Bronte Insieme/Storia Castello Nelson, trasformazioni e modifiche (4)".
