They are traditionally served at the kiddush in synagogues after Shabbat services and are also a popular dessert at Rosh Hashanah.

The cookie originated in Gibsonburg, Ohio, as an entry into the 1957 Pillsbury Bake-Off contest. The cookie was originally named Black-eyed Susans, but was renamed by Pillsbury to the Peanut Butter Blossom cookie. Traditional Jam Jams are made with either molasses or brown sugar. The cookies have a cakey texture and are filled with various jams, including raspberry, partridgeberry (lingonberry), bakeapple (cloudberry), or apple. The commercial version produced by Purity Industries uses an apple-based filling. Regional variations exist in both recipe and appearance, with some versions featuring a decorative hole in the top cookie to showcase the jam filling.

== Overview ==

Chocolate chip cookies are closely associated with the United States, where they are the most popular cookie. Their invention is generally credited to Massachusetts chef and hotelier Ruth Graves Wakefield in the 1930s, although versions existed that preceded hers. Over the 20th century they gained popularity through their association with the Swiss company Nestlé, their distribution to American troops in World War II, and the development of new versions in the 1970s and 1980s by manufacturers such as Famous Amos and Mrs. Fields.

The exact term "peanut butter blossom cookie" refers to the original variation of the cookie – a soft peanut butter cookie rolled in granulated

sugar and topped with a Hershey's Kiss. However, many variations on the recipe have since evolved to include different flavors, both in the dough or as the topping.

Greenspan initially pursued an academic path in gerontology. However, after the birth of her son, she found herself unable to finish her dissertation and uninterested in returning to academia. Her husband suggested she try baking, which became her entry point into the food industry. Greenspan found work as a baker, but was fired from her first baking job, describing her efforts as "terrible." She gradually built a career as a food writer, accepting small assignments and shadowing chefs.

Vora's family had given her three career paths to choose from (medicine, engineering, law), so she chose law. She continued to cook for her friends in college and law school, and received her degree in political science from the University of California, Berkeley in 2009 and her JD from Harvard Law School in 2012.

Founded in 1981, the Company's Coming series comprises over 200 cookbooks, each on a single subject.

At the age of 14, Vora began to teach herself how to cook by watching chefs such as Ina Garten and Alton Brown on the Food Network, spending time in the cookbook section of bookstores, and learning from her mother, who cooked Indian vegetarian cuisine.

Today cookie decorating traditions continue in many places in the world and include such activities as cookie decorating parties, competitions, creating cookie bouquets and cookie gift baskets, and simply decorating cookies with children as a fun family activity.

Kichlach seem to have developed in central or eastern Europe in Ashkenazi Jewish communities by the nineteenth century and subsequently gained popularity around the world with the diaspora and migrations in the twentieth century. Kiddush in early twentieth-century Ashkenazi synagogues centered around kichlach, pickled herring, and schnapps. Jews in South Africa still serve kichel with chopped herring, also a common practice in American synagogues until the 1950s. Kichlach are sometimes eaten with another kind of savoury dip or topping.
