Augustus De Morgan De Morgan’s first work on logic, First Notions Augustus De Morgan (27 June 1806 – 18 March 1871) was a British mathematician and logician. De Morgan's contributions to logic are heavily used in many branches of mathematics, including set theory and probability theory, as well as other related fields such as computer science. He is best known for De Morgan's laws, relating logical conjunction, disjunction, and negation, and for coining the term "mathematical induction", the underlying principles of which he formalized. of note is the introduction of hyperbolic functions and comparison of circular and hyperbolic trigonometry

Historically, the concept was elaborated with the infinitesimal calculus at the end of the 17th century, and, until the 19th century, the functions that were considered were differentiable (that is, they had a high degree of regularity). The concept of a function was formalized at the end of the 19th century in terms of set theory, and this greatly increased the possible applications of the concept. $\{s_n\}$
