Textual criticism Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work. Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant. This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. Intentional alterations may have been made as well, for example, the censoring of printed work for political, religious or cultural. and expense of producing superior editions of his works have always been widely viewed as worthwhile. Lean manufacturing One distinguishing feature opposes lean accounting and standard cost accounting. For standard cost accounting, SKUs are difficult to grasp. Lean manufacturing adopts the just-in-time approach and additionally focuses on reducing cycle, flow, and throughput times by further eliminating activities that do not add any value for the customer. Just-in-time manufacturing tries to match production to demand by only supplying goods that have been ordered and focus on efficiency, productivity (with a commitment to continuous

improvement), and reduction of "wastes" for the producer and supplier of goods. It is closely related to another concept called just-in-time manufacturing (JIT manufacturing in short). Lean manufacturing also involves people who work outside of. Comparative advantage In a famous example, Ricardo considers Comparative advantage in an economic model is the advantage over others in producing a particular good. e. at a lower relative marginal cost prior to trade. Comparative advantage describes the economic reality of the gains from trade for individuals, firms, or nations, which arise from differences in their factor endowments or technological progress. become known as the theory of comparative advantage in his book On the Principles of Political Economy and Taxation.
