247675f0ab The long-wristed hermit crab inhabits the empty shells of gastropods such as periwinkles, snails, and oyster drills for mobile shelter and protection of their soft abdomens. They anchor themselves into the shells by wrapping their abdomens around the columella, or axis, inside the vacant shell. Hermit crabs cannot produce their own shells, and therefore must scavenge for abandoned ones. Shell selection plays many crucial roles in *P. longicarpus*, such as providing protection from predators, desiccation and salinity stress, as well as influencing competition, population size, and reproductive behaviors in the species.

247675f0ab *C. sapidus* is of considerable culinary and economic importance in

the United States, particularly in Louisiana, the Carolinas, the Chesapeake Bay, Delaware, and New Jersey. It is Maryland's largest commercial fishery and has been designated its state crustacean. Due to overfishing and environmental pressures some of the fisheries have seen declining yields, especially in the Chesapeake Bay fishery. 247675f0ab Hermit crabs can be identified by the colouration of their antenna and their antennules (a small structure resembling antennae which sits in front of the actual antennae). The hermit crab is approximately the size of a coin and on average 56mm in length, but this is slightly limited by the size of the shells available. The species is popular among aquarium enthusiasts, but due to the encountered difficulty of breeding them in captivity, they are typically wild caught, which could impact the species' numbers, leading them to become endangered in the near future. The crab's abdomen is spiral shaped, and can twist, so they can fit easily into the different shells they take on throughout their life. The crab protects itself from danger by contracting rapidly back into its shell. It uses its large chela as a door which protects it once it has retreated back into the safety of its shell. Throughout their lifetime hermit crabs adopt empty mollusk and gastropod shells to protect their soft and vulnerable abdomens. The crabs carry their shells around on their backs with small legs which are modified so that their back end can grip into the shell; they use their abdominal muscles to hold themselves securely in place.
