Stonor Letters writing: 1) dictating a letter to a literate transcriber; 2) dictating the content but personally writing a signature, greetings, and postscript; and The Stonor Letters are one of the significant collections of 15th century correspondence that have survived. This series of documents, though not the earliest private letters known in English, has more number and variety in terms of interest, along with the other two major collections from this period, which are the Paston Letters and the Cely Letters

Birch bark manuscript The Irish language's native writing system Ogham, sometimes called the "tree Birch bark manuscripts are documents written on pieces of the outer layer of birch bark, which was commonly used for writing before the mass production of paper. The oldest such manuscripts are the numerous Gandhāran Buddhist texts from approximately the 1st century CE, from what is now Afghanistan. Evidence of birch bark for writing goes back many centuries and appears in various cultures. are letters written by various people in a local dialect, Old Novgorodian. They contain among the earliest known versions of significant Buddhist scriptures, including a Dhammapada, discourses of Buddha that include the Rhinoceros Sutra, Avadanas and Abhidharma texts

Some researchers suggest that the study of "literacy" as a concept can be divided into two periods: the period before 1950, when literacy was understood solely as alphabetical literacy (word and letter recognition); and the period after 1950, when literacy slowly began to be considered as a wider concept and process, including the social and cultural aspects of reading, writing, and functional literacy

Each historical invention of writing emerged from systems of proto-writing that used ideographic and mnemonic symbols but were not capable of fully recording spoken language. True writing, where the content of linguistic utterances can be accurately reconstructed by later readers, is a later development. As proto-writing is not capable of fully reflecting the grammar and lexicon used in languages, it is often only capable of encoding broad or imprecise information.

Ruq'ah script functional style of writing that is quick to write and easy to read. It is a relatively simple and plain style, used for everyday writing and often used for signs. Every literate Ottoman was expected to be able to use the ruq'ah. The demonstration below Ruq'ah (Arabic: رُقْعَة) or Riq'ah (Arabic: رِقْعَة) is a writing style of Arabic script intended for the rapid production of texts. The Ottoman calligraphers Mumtaz Efendi (1810–1872) and Mustafa Izzet Efendi (1801–1876) are credited with standardizing the writing style which had existed in slightly different styles as everyday handwriting 6216d802d2

Camarão Indians' letters Today, the correspondence is stored in the archives of the Royal Library of the Netherlands, and has been preserved there for almost 400 years. They are the only known texts written by Brazilian Indians until the Independence of Brazil. Furthermore, the authors of the letters Diogo da Costa, Diogo Pinheiro Camarão, Filipe Camarão and Simão Soares - were probably literate in Portuguese - Camarão Indians' letters (Portuguese: cartas dos índios Camarões), also known as Tupi letters from Camarão Indians (Portuguese: cartas tupis dos Camarões), are a series of six letters exchanged between Potiguara Indians during 1645, in the first half of the 17th century, in the context of the Dutch invasions of Brazil. The Camarão Indians' letters are also the only record of Old Tupi writing in Colonial Brazil 6216d802d2

Writing is a cognitive and social activity involving neuropsychological and physical processes. The outcome of this activity, also called writing (or a text) is a series of physically inscribed, mechanically transferred, or digitally represented symbols. Reading is the corresponding process of interpreting a written text, with the interpreter referred to as a reader. 6216d802d2

Japanese writing system Almost all written Japanese sentences contain a mixture of kanji and kana. Initially Chinese characters were not used for writing Japanese The modern Japanese writing system uses a combination of logographic kanji, which are adopted Chinese characters, and syllabic kana. Because of this mixture of scripts, in addition to a large inventory of kanji characters, the Japanese writing system is considered to be one of the most complicated currently in use. that the Japanese became literate in Chinese writing any earlier than the 4th century AD. Kana itself consists of a pair of syllabaries: hiragana, used primarily for native or naturalized Japanese words and grammatical elements; and katakana, used primarily for foreign words and names, loanwords, onomatopoeia, scientific names, and sometimes for emphasis 6216d802d2

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
