Ward Cunningham He co-authored (with Bo Leuf) a book about wikis, entitled *The Wiki Way*, and invented the Framework for Integrated Test. , a consultancy that has specialized in object-oriented programming. He began coding the WikiWikiWeb in 1994, and installed it on c2. Called a pioneer, and innovator, he also helped create both software design patterns and extreme programming. Cunningham Inc. com (the website of his software consulting firm) on March 25, 1995, as an add-on to the Portland Pattern Repository. Cunningham (born May 26, 1949) is an American computer programmer who developed the first wiki and was a co-author of the Manifesto for Agile Software Development. Speakeasy (computational environment) **Speakeasy** is a vector-oriented language: giving a structured argument to a function of a scalar, the result is usually an object with the same structure **Speakeasy** was a numerical computing interactive environment also featuring an interpreted programming language. He eventually founded **Speakeasy Computing Corporation** to make the program available commercially.
