Technological unemployment the ideal solution to technological unemployment, as unlike welfare or guaranteed income schemes they provide people with the social recognition and meaningful The term technological unemployment is used to describe the loss of jobs caused by technological change. Technological change typically includes the introduction of labour-saving "mechanical-muscle" machines or more efficient "mechanical-mind" processes (automation), and humans' role in these processes are minimized. A contemporary example. Historical examples include artisan

weavers reduced to poverty after the introduction of mechanized looms (See: Luddites). Just as horses were gradually made obsolete as transport by the automobile and as labourer by the tractor, humans' jobs have also been affected throughout modern history. Thousands of man-years of work was performed in a matter of hours by the bombe codebreaking machine during World War II. It is a key type of structural unemployment

Credit rating agency An agency may rate the creditworthiness of issuers of debt obligations, of debt instruments, and in some cases, of the servicers of the underlying debt, but not of individual consumers. From 2000 A credit rating agency (CRA, also called a ratings service) is a company that assigns credit ratings, which rate a debtor's ability to pay back debt by making timely principal and interest payments and the likelihood of default. subprime

Tendency of the rate of profit to fall In *Capital*, Volume I (1867) he noted that “many intermediate terms” were still The tendency of the rate of profit to fall (TRPF) is a theory in the crisis theory of political economy, according to which the rate of profit—the ratio of the profit to the amount of invested capital—decreases over time. first attempt at a solution occurs in a letter to Engels, dated 2 August 1862. This hypothesis gained additional prominence from its discussion by Karl Marx in Chapter 13 of *Capital*, Volume III, but economists as diverse as Adam Smith, John Stuart Mill, David Ricardo and William Stanley Jevons referred explicitly to the TRPF as an empirical phenomenon that demanded further theoretical explanation, although they differed on the reasons why the TRPF should

necessarily occur. Some scholars, such as David Harvey, argue against the TRPF as a quantitative phenomenon, arguing it is an internal logic driving the movement of capital itself d3cf98cb2a

Among the elements, fluorine ranks 24th in cosmic abundance

and 13th in crustal abundance. Fluorite, the primary mineral source of fluorine, which gave the element its name, was first described in 1529; as it was added to metal ores to lower their melting points for smelting, the Latin verb fluo meaning 'to flow' gave the mineral its name. Proposed as an element in 1810, fluorine proved difficult and dangerous to separate from its compounds, and several early experimenters died or sustained injuries from their attempts... d3cf98cb2a
