In 1968 she met Serge Gainsbourg while co-starring with him in *Slogan*, which marked the beginning of a years-long working and personal relationship. The duo released a debut album, *Jane Birkin/Serge Gainsbourg*, in 1969, and Birkin appeared in the film *Je t'aime moi non plus* in 1976 under Gainsbourg's direction. Background and release Jane was the great-granddaughter of Henry VII (through his youngest surviving daughter, Mary Tudor), the grandniece of Henry VIII, and the first cousin once removed of Edward VI, Mary I, and Elizabeth I. Under the will of Henry VIII, Jane was in line to the throne after her cousins. She had a humanist education and a reputation as one of the most learned young women of her day. In May 1553, she was married to Lord Guildford Dudley, a younger son of Edward VI's chief minister, John Dudley, Duke of Northumberland. In June, the dying Edward VI wrote his will, nominating Jane and her male heirs as successors to the Crown, in part because his half-sister Mary was Catholic, whereas Jane was a committed Protestant and would support the reformed Church of England, whose foundation Edward laid. The...
Jane Wyman made her theatrical film debut in *The Kid from Spain* (1932) as an uncredited chorus girl. Wyman always maintained that she got her start in 1934 at 17 dancing in the chorus for LeRoy Prinz at Paramount Pictures. In 1936 Bryan Foy signed Wyman, at 19 years old, to her first studio contract with Warner Bros. During her tenure there, Wyman began appearing in bit roles but progressed into supporting roles, including *My Love Came Back* (1940), *Footlight Serenade* (1942), and *Princess O'Rourke* (1943).
