Gender roles in childhood By ten months, infants can associate certain objects with females and males, like a hammer with males or scarf with females. Gender roles are influenced by the media, family, the environment, and society. Children between Gender roles are culturally influenced stereotypes which create expectations for appropriate behavior for males and females. In addition to biological maturation, children develop within a set of gender-specific social and behavioral norms embedded in family structure, natural play patterns, close friendships, and the teeming social jungle of school life. Children between 3 and 6 months can form distinctions between male and female faces. The gender roles encountered in childhood play a large part in shaping an individual. Children's rights " Children's rights includes their right to association with both parents, human identity as well as the basic needs for physical protection, food, universal state-paid education, health care, and criminal laws appropriate for the age and

development of the child, equal protection of the child's civil rights, and freedom from discrimination on the basis of the child's race, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, religion. The 1989 Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) defines a child as "any human being below the age of eighteen years, unless under the law applicable to the child, majority is attained earlier. used to describe young people such as "adolescents", "teenagers", or "youth" in international law, but the children's rights movement is considered distinct Children's rights or the rights of children are a subset of human rights with particular attention to the rights of special protection and care afforded to minors

These disorders negatively impact the mental and social wellbeing of a child, and children with these disorders require support from their families and schools. Childhood mental disorders often persist into adulthood. that is below average, and the failure to meet developmentally appropriate intellectual goals.
