Baffin Bay It is sometimes considered a sea of the North Atlantic Ocean. The English explorer **Baffin Bay** (Inuktitut: Saknirutiak Imanga; Greenlandic: Avannaata Imaa; French: Baie de Baffin; Danish: Baffinsbugten), located between Baffin Island and the west coast of Greenland, is defined by the International Hydrographic Organization as a marginal sea of the Arctic Ocean. However, a polynya of about 80,000 km² (31,000 sq mi), known as the North Water, opens in summer on the north near Smith Sound. The narrower Nares Strait connects Baffin Bay with the Arctic Ocean. Most of the aquatic life of the bay is concentrated near. also suggest that the Norse colonization of the Americas reached the shores of Baffin Bay sometime between the 10th and 15th centuries. The bay is not navigable most of the year because of the ice cover and high density of floating ice and icebergs in the open areas.
