However, the technique can be applied to any medical study where a pathological process can be imaged. much work to perform the segmentation manually for every single image if a radiomics database with lots of data is created. Radiomics emerged from the medical fields of radiology and oncology and is the most advanced in applications within these fields. The hypothesis of radiomics is that the distinctive imaging features between disease forms may be useful for predicting prognosis and therapeutic response for various cancer types, thus providing valuable information for personalized therapy. These features, termed radiomic features, have the potential to uncover tumoral patterns and characteristics that fail to be appreciated by the naked eye 2b21a8fab5
