The first two generations were engineered by Nissan's Aichi Manufacturing Division for private, personal ownership, with the last two generations built by Mazda, rebadged as Nissans and refocused as commercial vehicles, based on the Mazda Bongo 0e99753fbe

sedan called the Nissan Teana which was between the Altima and Maxima in terms of size.
