"Vikramaditya" was also a common title adopted by several monarchs in ancient and medieval India, and the Vikramaditya legends may be embellished accounts of different kings (particularly Chandragupta II). Many describe him as ruler with his capital at Ujjain (Pataliputra or Pratihasthana in a few stories).
