Michael Jackson albums discography Jackson is one of the best-selling music artists in history with over 500 million records sold worldwide. Jackson made his debut at the age of six as the lead singer of The Jackson 5 (later known as The Jacksons) in 1964, who were prominent performers during the 1970s. Estate of Michael Jackson According to Jackson's will, his assets and posthumous earnings are allocated to a trust, with 40% to his mother, 40% to his three children, and the remaining 20% to unspecified charities. The Associated Press reported that, in 2007, Jackson had a net worth of US\$237 million: \$568 million in assets, which included Neverland Ranch and his 50% share of the Sony/ATV Music Publishing catalog, and debts of \$331 million. there were unprecedented... In the early 1980s, Jackson became a dominant figure in popular culture and the first African-American entertainer to have a strong crossover fanbase on MTV. The popularity of his music videos that aired on MTV such as "Billie Jean", "Beat It" and "Thriller"—credited for transforming the music video from a promotional tool into an art form—helped bring fame to the relatively new channel. The success of these music videos helped shift MTV's focus from its original "rock 'n' roll only" format to pop and R&B and saved the channel from financial ruin. Jackson rose to solo stardom with *Off the Wall* (1979) and achieved unprecedented global success with *Thriller* (1982), the best-selling album in history. The stage was filled with floral arrangements, with photographs and film of Jackson and the Jackson 5 projected onto screens at the back. Music and video montages traced his life from
