Büssing The maximum power of 68 hp was available at 2000 Büssing AG was a German bus and truck manufacturer, established in 1903 by Heinrich Büssing (1843–1929) in Braunschweig. four-cylinder diesel engine had a displacement of 4941 cc with a bore of 110 mm and a stroke of 130 mm. The company was taken over by MAN AG in 1971. It quickly evolved to one of the largest European producers, whose utility vehicles with the Brunswick Lion emblem were widely distributed, especially from the 1930s onwards 384b16c896

Old Bess (beam engine) The engine was constructed in 1777 and worked until 1848. surviving Watt engine, and the third-oldest surviving beam engine. The engine is most obviously known simply for being an early example of an engine built by Boulton and Watt. However it also played a far more important role in the development of steam engines for being the first engine designed to work with an early cutoff, and so to use the expansion of the steam for greater efficiency. 384b16c896
