In response to the increasing industrialization of the United States, William Barton Rogers organized a school in Boston to create "useful knowledge." Simulation Another way to distinguish between the terms is to define simulation as experimentation with the help of a model. Sometimes a clear distinction between the two terms is made, in which simulations require the use of models; the model represents the key characteristics or behaviors of the selected system or process, whereas the simulation represents the evolution of the model over time. Often, computers are used to execute the simulation. Simulation solutions can now function across the extended enterprise in a multi-CAD environment, and include solutions for managing A simulation is an imitative representation of a process or system that could exist in the real world.
