Vsevolod Pudovkin Vsevolod's mother Yelizaveta Aleksandrovna Pudovkina (née Shilkina) was a housewife. Pudovkin's masterpieces are often contrasted with those of his contemporary Sergei Eisenstein; Eisenstein utilized montage to glorify the power of the masses, while Pudovkin preferred to concentrate on the courage and resilience of individuals. He was granted the title of People's Artist of the USSR in 1948. Bradley's only printed work, The British Housewife was released as a 42-issue partwork between January and October 1756. It was published in a two-volume book form in 1758, and is more than a thousand pages long. It is likely that Bradley was dead before the partwork was published. The book follows the French style of nouvelle cuisine, distinguishing Bradley from other female cookery book writers at the time, who focused on the British or English style of food preparation. Paulette Bernège Although her ideal home was too expensive for most people in the period before World War II (1939–45), her work led to more efficient designs in French apartments and houses built after the war. She thought housework should be measured, analyzed and organized for efficiency in the same way as factory work. She was a pioneer in applying scientific principles to the study of housework and to the design of living

spaces and appliances that would make this work more efficient. scientific standards for workshops, intended to streamline the work of a housewife with or without the help of a cleaning woman. Bernège saw herself as an Paulette Bernège (1896 – 25 November 1973) was a French journalist, publicist and author who specialized in housework and home economics.
