French on English pertains mainly to its lexicon, including orthography, and to some extent pronunciation. Old French, specifically the Old Norman dialect, became the language of the new Anglo-Norman court, the government, and the elites. However, English has continued to be influenced by French. Most of the French vocabulary in English entered the language after the Norman Conquest in 1066. That period lasted for several centuries through the Hundred Years' War (1337-1453) 4894711b5b
