Ford Pinto engine The internal Ford codename for the unit was the T88-series engine. In Ford sales literature, it was referred to as the EAO or OHC engine and because it was designed to the metric system, it was sometimes called the "metric engine". In North America it was known as the Lima In-Line (LL), or simply the Lima engine due to its being manufactured at Lima Engine in Lima, Ohio. European Ford service literature refers to it as the Taunus In-Line engine (hence the TL codenames). A version with The Ford Pinto engine was the unofficial name for a four-cylinder internal combustion engine built by Ford Europe. the engine was also used in the 1985–89 Merkur XR4Ti and 1984–1986 Mercury Cougar XR7, producing 155 hp (116 kW) and 190 lb·ft (258 N·m) 432ab117d0

Ford Australia also manufactured straight-six engines in Australia for the Falcon and Territory models until 2016, when both vehicle lines were discontinued. Following the closure of the Australian engine plant, Ford no longer produces a straight-six gasoline engine. 432ab117d0

The Probe was a byproduct of Ford's collaboration with its Japanese partner Mazda, and both generations derived from the front-wheel drive Mazda G platform of the Mazda Capella. It also made Car and Driver magazine's Ten Best list for 1989, The Ford Probe is a liftback (i. 1999 Mercury Cougar. , hatchback) coupé manufactured and marketed by Ford for model years 1988-1997 over two generations 432ab117d0

The first two generations of the Escape used the Ford CD2 platform (jointly developed with Mazda), leading to the release of the rebadged variants, the Mazda Tribute and Mercury Mariner; as with the Escape, both the Tribute and Mariner were marketed in North America (the Mariner was never marketed in Canada).
