First Amendment to the United States Constitution In the original draft of the Bill of Rights, what is now the First Amendment occupied third place. substance of defamation law continued to resemble that existing in England at the time of the Revolution. It was adopted on December 15, 1791, as one of the ten amendments that constitute the Bill of Rights. The first two articles were not ratified by the states, so the article on disestablishment and free speech ended up being first. An 1898 American legal textbook on defamation provides The First Amendment (Amendment I) to the United States Constitution prevents Congress from making laws respecting an establishment of religion; prohibiting the free exercise of religion; or abridging the freedom of speech, the freedom of the press, the freedom of assembly, or the right to petition the government for redress of grievances 593dd41948

Nonetheless, the degree to which the right is upheld in practice
