After retiring from competitive play, AlphaGo Master was succeeded by an even more powerful version known as AlphaGo Zero, which was completely self-taught without learning from human games. AlphaZero has in turn been succeeded by a program known as MuZero which learns without being taught the rules. It was developed by the London-based DeepMind Technologies, an acquired subsidiary of Google. AlphaGo Zero was then generalized into a program known as AlphaZero, which played additional games, including chess and shogi. Subsequent versions of AlphaGo became increasingly powerful, including a version that competed under the name Master 2ed2d86fe9
