Unwin, requested a sequel, and Tolkien offered a draft of the writings that would later become *The Silmarillion*. It was edited, partly written, and published posthumously by his son Christopher in 1977, assisted by Guy Gavriel Kay, who became a fantasy author. Unwin rejected this proposal, calling the draft obscure and "too. Sauron, a powerful servant of Melkor, imprisoned Beren, but with Lúthien's help *The Silmarillion* (Quenya: [silma'ril:ion]) is a book consisting of a collection of myths and stories in varying styles by the English writer J. R. R. Tolkien. Beren set out, and Lúthien joined him, though he tried to dissuade her. It tells of Eä, a fictional universe that includes the Blessed Realm of Valinor, the ill-fated region of Beleriand, the island of Númenor, and the continent of Middle-earth, where Tolkien's most popular works—*The Hobbit* and *The Lord of the Rings*—are set.
