List of secondary education systems by country ICSE is generally considered to be more rigorous than the CBSE AISSE Secondary education covers two phases on the ISCED scale. CBSE exams at grade 10 and 12 have often been compared to ICSE and ISC examinations. Level 2 or lower secondary education is considered the second and final phase of basic education, and level 3 or upper secondary education is the stage before tertiary education. Secondary education typically takes place after six years of primary education and is followed by higher education, vocational education or employment.
