TSS (operating system) The Resident Supervisor of TSS/370 was used as the basis for a port of UNIX to the IBM mainframe. Made available on a trial basis to a limited set of customers in 1967, it was never officially released as a supported product by IBM. TSS/360 also inspired the development of the TSS/8 operating system. TSS pioneered a number of novel features, some of which later appeared in more popular systems such as MVS. User-developed improvements and patches were frequently incorporated into the official source code. TSS was migrated to System/370 and 303x systems, but despite its many advances and novel capabilities, TSS failed to meet expectations and was eventually canceled. While nroff was intended to produce output on terminals and line printers, troff was intended to produce output on typesetting systems, specifically the Graphic Systems CAT, which had been introduced in 1972. These are driven by pressurized gas delivered by a regulator, and can either be automatic or manually controlled. The third type is an oxygen powered resuscitator. The second type is the expired air or breath powered resuscitator. The most popular type of gas powered resuscitator are time cycled, volume constant ventilators.
