Properties of metals, metalloids and nonmetals Metalloids are metallic-looking, often brittle solids that are either semiconductors or exist in semiconducting forms, and have amphoteric or weakly acidic oxides. Typical elemental nonmetals have a dull, coloured or colourless appearance; are often brittle when solid; are poor conductors of heat and electricity; and have acidic oxides. predominantly basic oxide. Most metals are silvery looking, high density, relatively soft and easily deformed solids with good electrical and thermal conductivity The chemical elements can be broadly divided into metals, metalloids, and nonmetals according to their shared physical and chemical properties. All elemental metals have a shiny appearance (at least when freshly polished); are good conductors of heat and electricity; form alloys with other metallic elements; and have at least one basic oxide. Most or some elements in each category share a range of other properties; a few elements have properties that are either 3902a0a71f
