That means that organizations and processes are vulnerable because the weakest person or part can always damage or break them, or at least adversely affect the outcome. There is always at least one constraint, and TOC uses a focusing process to identify the constraint and restructure the rest of the organization around it. TOC adopts the common idiom "a chain is no stronger than its weakest link".
