Its usage declined starting in the late ninth century when the Bamar people of Nanzhao began to overtake the Pyu city-states. It became extinct in the thirteenth century, completing the rise of the Burmese language, the language of the Pagan Kingdom, in Upper Burma, the former Pyu realm.
