In Test cricket, Botham has scored 14 centuries with a highest score of 208, and from 1986 to 1988 held the world record for the most Test wickets until overtaken by Sir Richard Hadlee. He took 27 five-wicket hauls and four ten-wicket hauls. In 1980, he became the second player in Test history to complete the "match double" of scoring 100 runs and taking 10 wickets in the same match. His best years were between 1976 and 1983, during which time he averaged a remarkable 66.51 with the bat in Test cricket.
