To conclude the tour, she returned to Italy and performed during November–December and finally end the promotion. Due to the massive sold-out shows and tickets demand for the tour, the World Tour 2009 took place in Milan during six nights, five in Rome; the shows in Turin and Florence were triplicated while in Bologna... == Background ==

Adriano in Siria (Mysliveček) It was composed to a libretto of the same name by the Italian poet Metastasio that was first performed in 1732 with music of Antonio Caldara and in more than 60 further settings until 1828. The cuts and changes in the text made for the 1776 performance of Mysliveček's opera are not attributable. All of Mysliveček's operas are of the serious type in Italian referred to as opera seria that featured the designation *dramma per musica* in librettos. No other of the composer's settings of Metastasio's texts contains as many substitute aria texts as this one does. His setting of Metastasio's *Adriano in Siria* is one of the finest ever composed in the 18th century. For a performance in the 1770s, it would only be expected that a libretto of such age would be abbreviated and altered to suit contemporary operatic taste. "Che fa il mio bene" [a non-Metastasian text] Act 2, scene 6 – Aria of Sabina, "Volga il ciel, felici amanti" [a non-Metastasian text] Act 2, scene 7 – *Adriano in Siria* ("Hadrian in Syria") is an 18th-century Italian opera seria in 3 acts by the Czech composer Josef Mysliveček

She worked with Roberto De Simone, who engaged her in significant roles in such performances as *La Gatta Cenerentola*, staged in the gardens of the Palais Royal, Paris; at Sadler's Wells Theatre, London; Festival Grec, Barcelona (1999/2000); and the major Italian theaters (Teatro La Pergola, Florence; Teatro Bonci, Cesena; Piccolo Teatro, Milan; Arena del Sole, Bologna, Teatro Valli, Reggio Emilia), *Lo Vommaro a duello* (2008), a production of the Teatro di San Carlo for the "Napoli Teatro Festival" Italia. The concert performance of *Li Turchi Viaggiano* by De Simone, toured Argentina in 2001 (Teatro Coliseo, Buenos Aires, Gran Teatro de Cordoba, El Circulo Theater, Rosario; Teatro Apolo, Mar del Plata, Teatro Municipal, Bahia Blanca; Teatro del Bicentenario, San Juan) as well as Uruguay (Theatre Star of Italy, Montevideo). Fiorenza's vocal repertoire includes neapolitan songs, various jazz forms, and many Mediterranean influences.

== Biography ==

After the album *SXM* with the rap group *Sangue Misto*, in 1996 Neffa started his solo career, with the successful album *I messaggeri della dopa* which was led by the single "Aspettando il sole". In the following albums he spanned various styles including funk, pop, soul, jazz and R&B, achieving major success in 2001 with the summer hit "La mia signorina" and the accompanying album *Arrivi e partenze*. The same year he was nominated as best Italian act at the MTV Europe Music Awards. In 2004 he entered the main competition at the 54th edition of the Sanremo Music Festival, placing ninth with the song "Le ore piccole..."

He taught musical composition at the Milan Conservatory, Florence, Pesaro Conservatory and Bologna Conservatory.

== History ==

== Background information == In his earliest works, from *Musica per un'azione immaginaria* to *L'art pour l'art?*, he tries to incorporate graphical elements into the music, and in so doing, he clearly shows his structuralist approach, which only later becomes more informal. *Nafshi*, *Recit* and other compositions show a turning point in his way of composing, since he pays more attention to the form, which is thought of as a synthesis of a fluid episodic multiplicity. Through his *Pierrot* series, he was able to reveal a "melodic" component of his music, which broadens in the opera *Trionfo della notte* (1986–87 season at the Teatro Comunale di Bologna), which won the Premio Abbiati as the best composition... == Early life and education == Fiorenza Calogero was born on 7 July, 1978, in Castellammare di Stabia. After the general rehearsal on 13 July in Jesolo, the tour officially began with two concerts at the Circus Maximus in Rome on 21 and 22 July. After performing in Italy, Pausini started the American tour on 26 July in Miami, United States and ended the American leg on 31 August at the Radio City Music Hall in New York City. After performing in Italy between September and October, she performed in several European countries in October to return to Italy and finish the tour in Eboli. This was the first time that she presented herself in cities like Guayaquil in Ecuador and Brasília and Recife in Brazil. It is also the first time she returned to Guatemala after 21 years of absence. The tour ended officially in Monte Carlo on 31 December 2018. On 30 December 2010, Pausini announced her eleventh studio album, *Inedito / Inédito*, which was set to be released in both Italian and Spanish on 11 November 2011. The title and tracklist of the album were revealed on Pausini's website on 10 September 2011. The first single from the album, "Benvenuto" / "Bienvenido," was released on 12 September 2011. The album was released on 11 November 2011, after which Pausini embarked on her sixth world tour, starting in Italy during the last two weeks of December. The tour then continued in South America and Europe during the first half of 2012, with plans to return to South America later in 2012. Born in Scafati, at a young age Pellino moved to Bologna with his family. In the late 1980s he adopted the stage name Jeff Pellino and was a drummer in several rock and punk bands, notably *Negazione*. In 1991, he joined the hip hop ensemble *Isola Posse All Stars* and adopted the stage name "Neffa" in honour of Paraguayan footballer Gustavo Neffa, at the time playing with U.S. Cremonese. == Life and career == == Biography == Pietro is the son of Gianni Morandi and his second wife Anna Dan; on his father's side, he has two half-siblings, actress Marianna Morandi and singer Marco Morandi. From an early age, he was drawn to music, particularly rap, and began writing his first songs in middle school. He attended the "Marco Minghetti" classical high school in Bologna. The opera was first performed at the Teatro del Cocomero in Florence on 8 September 1776 as the last dramatic composition he produced for the musical public of that city. The electoral court of Munich intended to engage Mysliveček... During 2008, the singer announced about touring a whole year during 2009 from February to December, which gives her performances in Italy, Europe and the Americas. The tour took place in important cities like Madrid, Barcelona, Paris, Zürich, Geneva,

Helsinki, Turku, Stockholm, Brussels and others. Then, made a few stops on North American cities, such as Dominican Republic, United States, Canada and Mexico; continues to South America reaching Argentina, Chile, Peru and Brasil. 1fefe48db7

It was planned to visit America, Europe, and Australia but ended on 15 September 2012, after Pausini announced she was pregnant.
