Criminal Code of Russia The new Criminal Code replaced the Soviet analogue of 1960. The 1996 Criminal Code of the Russian Federation (UGKRF) came into force on January 1, 1997. He was a Research Fellow from 1936 to 1942 and completed his Doctor of Philosophy degree in law at St John's College, Cambridge, where he was examined by the Vinerian Professor of English Law at Oxford, Sir William Searle Holdsworth, who was at the time, a Fellow of St John's College, Oxford.
