

# Cartooning The Ultimate Character Design Book

The character's popularity spawned a spin-off franchise of theatrical shorts, television cartoons and merchandise. He starred in 124 short films, four TV series and four TV specials. **Ben Tennyson** Across these iterations, he matures from a reckless and adventurous child into a capable and responsible hero once he obtains the Omnitrix, a watch-like device which allows him to turn into various alien species. The character's middle name, Kirby, was conceived as a reference to comic book artist Jack Kirby. Initial concepts for Ben's Alien Force and Ultimate Benjamin Kirby "Ben" Tennyson, commonly known as Ben 10, is a superhero and the titular protagonist of the Ben 10 franchise. The franchise has been rebooted twice, first in the animated series Ben 10 (2016–2021), and then in the Dynamite Comics series Ben 10 (2026), reimagining the character as a 10-year-old for a modern audience. The version of Ben Tennyson presented in the first four series is identified as Ben Prime from the Prime Timeline, making him the progenitor of the entire multiverse. Created by Man of Action and produced by Cartoon Network Studios, he first appeared in the animated series Ben 10 (2005–2008), following his journey through Ben 10: Alien Force (2008–2010), Ben 10: Ultimate Alien (2010–2012), Ben 10: Omniverse (2012–2014)

The teenage son of a Black American father and an Afro-Puerto Rican mother, Miles Morales is the second Spider-Man to appear in Ultimate Marvel, an imprint with a separate continuity from the mainstream Marvel Universe called the Ultimate Universe (Earth-1610). He first appeared in Ultimate Fallout #4 (August 2011), following the death of the Ultimate Peter Parker. The character was initially introduced in the alternate Earth-1610 (portrayed in the Ultimate Universe comics), in which he was bitten by a spider genetically engineered at the behest of Norman Osborn in an attempt to duplicate the abilities of Spider-Man. He was featured in the Ultimate Comics: Spider-Man comic book series. After Marvel ended the Ultimate imprint in 2015, Miles was transported to the main Marvel Universe (Earth-616), beginning with stories under the All... d8d6d1bb66 Farago was born in the 1970s in Ohio, United States. Sega sought a mascot to compete with Nintendo's Mario, and Ohshima designed Sonic based on a prototype programmed by Naka. Sonic's design was influenced by a variety of sources, including Felix the Cat, Mickey Mouse, Michael Jackson, and Santa Claus; his pigmentation was chosen to match Sega's cobalt blue logo. Yuji Uekawa redesigned Sonic for Sonic Adventure (1998) to suit the franchise's transition to 3D computer graphics, with a more mature look designed to appeal to older players. The first volume, published between 2005 and 2006, was a five-part miniseries depicting the early life and origins of Tony Stark, and was drawn by Andy Kubert.
