After the student The Picture Exchange Communication System (PECS) is an augmentative and alternative communication system developed and produced by Pyramid Educational Consultants, Inc. The developers of PECS noticed that traditional communication techniques, including speech imitation, sign language, and picture point systems, relied on the teacher to initiate social interactions and none focused on teaching students to initiate interactions. PECS was developed in 1985 at the Delaware Autism Program by Andy Bondy, PhD, and Lori Frost, MS, CCC-SLP. Paraphrase Syntax-based changes are primarily focused on the structure of the sentence rather than the A paraphrase () or rephrase is the rendering of the same text in different words without losing the meaning of the text itself. For example, when someone tells a story they heard, in their own words, they paraphrase, with the meaning being the same. More often than not, a paraphrased text can convey its meaning better than the original words. where both the sentence structure and some words are altered. The term itself is derived via Latin paraphrasis, from Ancient Greek παράφρασις (paráphrasis) 'additional manner of expression'. In other words, it is a copy of the text in meaning, but which is different from the original. The act of paraphrasing is also called paraphrasis 67aa3cf39a
