Grilling Sear-grilling instantly sears the outside of meat to make the food more flavorful. Food to be grilled is cooked on a grill (an open wire grid such as a gridiron with a heat source above or below), using a cast iron/frying pan, or a grill pan (similar to a frying pan, but with raised ridges to mimic the wires of an open grill). heats the grill grates to temperatures over 480 °C (900 °F).
