William Blake (28 November 1757 –
12 August 1827) was an English
poet, painter, and printmaker.
What he called his "prophetic

works" were said by 20th-century critic Northrop Frye to form "what is in proportion to its merits the least read body of poetry in the English language". Largely unrecognised during his life, Blake has become a seminal figure in the history of the poetry and visual art of the Romantic Age
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Definitions vary considerably from one country to another, but usually treat ownership of the work as a whole as distinct from ownership of the individual contributions, so the individual authors may retain the right to publish their work elsewhere.
