Wicked problem Because of complex interdependencies, the effort to solve one aspect of a wicked problem may reveal or create other problems. Another definition is "a problem whose social complexity means that it has no determinable stopping point". Solutions to wicked problems are not right or wrong. It refers to an idea or problem that cannot be fixed, where there is no single solution to the problem; "wicked" does not indicate evil, but rather resistance to resolution. Every wicked problem is essentially novel and unique In planning and policy, a wicked problem is a problem that is difficult or impossible to solve because of incomplete, contradictory, and changing requirements that are often difficult to recognize. Wicked problems have no stopping rule. Due to their complexity, wicked problems are often characterized by organized irresponsibility. solution

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
