However, soon after, Talas weakened back into a tropical depression and dissipated as The 2022 Pacific typhoon season was the third consecutive season to have below average tropical cyclone activity, with twenty-five named storms

forming a tropical storm, and was given the international name of Talas. The season ran throughout 2022, though most tropical cyclones typically develop between May and October. The season saw near-average activity by named storm count, although many of the storms were weak and short-lived, particularly towards the end of the season. Tropical. This low activity was caused by an unusually strong La Niña that had persisted from 2020. The season's first named storm, Malakas, developed on April 6, while the last named storm, Pakhar, dissipated on December 12. The season's first typhoon, Malakas, reached typhoon status on April 12 e5f9133504

Turkmenistan, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan, and Kyrgyzstan. Sogdiana was first conquered by Cyrus the Great, the founder of the Achaemenid Empire, and then was annexed by the Macedonian ruler Alexander the Great in 328 BC. Sogdiana was also a province of the Achaemenid Empire, and listed on the Behistun Inscription of Darius the Great e5f9133504
