Discrimination protections in credit, housing, employment, education, and public accommodation have explicitly included sexual orientation since 2003 and gender identity or expression since 2019. The advocacy movement for LGBTQ rights in the state has been dated as far back as 1969 during the Stonewall riots in New York City. Transgender people in the state legally do not have to undergo sex reassignment surgery to change their sex or gender on official documents since 2014. Same-sex sexual activity between consenting adults has been legal since the New York v. Same-sex marriage has been legal statewide since 2011 and some cities have recognized domestic partnerships between same-sex couples since 1998. LGBTQ rights in Israel Israel became the first country in Asia to recognize unregistered cohabitation between same-sex couples, making it the first country in Asia to recognize same-sex unions in any capacity. In February 2020, the Israeli Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ) rights in Israel are considered the most developed in the Middle East and one of the most developed in Asia. Same-sex couples are allowed to jointly adopt, following a landmark court decision in 2008. Although same-sex sexual activity was legalized in 1988, the former law against sodomy had not been enforced against consenting adults following a directive from the Attorney General in 1953 and a Supreme Court decision in 1963. Despite the passage of the law, several court rulings have protected surrogacy rights for same-sex couples. Although same-sex marriages are not performed in the country, since Israel does not have civil non-religious marriages, and none of the recognized religious marriage institutions within the country perform same-sex marriages, Israeli law recognizes civil marriages (including same-sex marriages since 2006) performed elsewhere with the same legal rights as marriages performed in Israel. same-sex couples. Ladera Ranch is a 4,000-acre (16 km²) planned community, bordered by the cities of Mission Viejo and San Juan Capistrano to the west and the city of Rancho Santa Margarita to the north. Located along Antonio Parkway and Crown Valley Parkway, construction of the community began in 1999 on portions of the O'Neill, Avery, & Moiso families' 23,000-acre (93 km²) Rancho Mission Viejo cattle ranch, which was the largest remaining working ranch in Orange County. Connecticut* in 1965 and *Eisenstadt v. Baird* in 1972, that struck down "Comstock laws" that imposed government restrictions on contraceptives. In an effort to curb sex-selective abortion, Jiangxi and Guizhou restrict non-medically necessary abortions after 14 weeks of pregnancy, while throughout most of China abortions are legal after 14 weeks. Abortion regulations may vary depending on the rules of the province. Following the Chinese Communist Revolution and the proclamation of the People's Republic of China in 1949, the country has periodically switched between more restrictive abortion policies to more liberal abortion policies and reversals. Abortions are available to most women through China's family planning program, public hospitals, private hospitals, and clinics nationwide. The policy was viewed as a response to China's declining

IVF is a type of assisted reproductive technology (ART) used to treat infertility, enable gestational surrogacy, and, in combination with pre-implantation genetic testing, avoid the transmission of abnormal genetic conditions. When a fertilised egg from egg and sperm donors implants in the uterus of a genetically unrelated surrogate, the resulting child is also genetically unrelated to the surrogate. Some countries have banned or otherwise regulated the availability of IVF treatment, giving rise to fertility tourism. She initially cared for the children legitimately, in addition to having two of her own. She allowed many children in her care to die through neglect, which resulted in a conviction in 1879 and six months' hard labour. Later, she directly murdered children she "adopted", strangling at least some of them, and disposing of the bodies to avoid attention.
